Project overview

The Department of Psychology is seeking a part-time Research Associate to work with Dr. Karisha Kimone George on an Enhancing Research Culture funded project to develop an Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Research Centre. The Centre will be particularly focused on supporting research in relation to areas such as:

- decolonising research practice
- destabilising systemic inequalities
- pioneering innovative pedagogical practices which increase engagement among underrepresented student groups, and
- developing inclusive research methods and methodologies

Role

The post will involve running a series of focus groups to develop an understanding of core research projects that should be undertaken in each of these areas. These research projects will form the basis of a small research funding call to be launched next academic year.

Skills, Experience & Qualification needed

- Candidates should have a first degree, and be in the process of completing a PhD.
- Candidates should have some experience in performing qualitative research (specifically focus groups) and in performing thematic analysis.
- Experience in championing EDI is necessary.

The intern will be paid £18.67 an hour. The appointment is available from 13^{th} May $2024 - 14^{th}$ June 2024 for 2.5 days a week (17.5 hours a week).
